<p>3. Business Arising from Previous Minutes 3.1. As there were not enough attendees at the previous P & C Meeting the Executive Committee held a meeting to approve funds. These decisions were discussed and voted on in the Treasurer's part of the meeting 3.2. A query was raised about the decision made at the Executive Meeting regarding reordering black rain jackets, as not enough funds had been released to make the minimum order. It was stated that due to communication issues and lack of quorum to vote at the previous P & C meetings, the Uniform Shop request to reintroduce and reorder black rain jackets was not met. This will cause a delay in supply. 3.3.
