

Dear Families,

Welcome to Term 3. Thank you to our families for your support of both the Interschool Cross Country event and Open Night so far this term. We are keeping all our scheduled events for the term at this stage, and will always let the community know if there are any changes.

Our school COVID cases are increasing slightly at the moment, along with an apparent gastro bug and influenza. We are currently averaging 80 students a day absent, so we ask parents to once again be vigilant with your family's health, and take responsible precautions to protect yourselves and others.

Our Parent Reading Support Program is up and running this term, thank you to those parents who have volunteered to be part of the program. We will be calling for more volunteers later in the term, with an opportunity to shadow some of our current parents, and 'learn the ropes'. This program is part of our 'Find 15' reading initiative, and an opportunity for students to build confidence in reading fluency, and for parents to learn how to support readers.

A reminder to parents that it has been nearly two years since we introduced our new school logo uniforms, which means our old logo uniforms will be phased out at the end of the year. Apologies to parents that the school has not been clear regarding the phasing out process. The 'phasing out' of the old logo means that the uniform shop will not be selling any uniforms with the old logo from next year, hence old logo uniforms will naturally start to disappear. It is obviously the school's preference that from 2023 on students' only wear uniforms with the newer logo, however we understand that for some families, circumstances may prevent that from happening initially. School bags and any accessories can have the old or new logo, and there is no need to replace perfectly good, expensive jackets. Please be aware that class photos next year will require students to be in school shirts with the new logo. Our amazing uniform ladies have sourced a wonderful opportunity to re-use leftover stock and any old logo uniforms parents wish to donate. 'Clutterbugs' is a local business, operated by one person, with the aim of recycling items and making sure they get to people in need. The P and C will provide more details later in the year about how you can donate old logo uniforms, but in the meantime please check out the website. Clutterbugs — Helping those who need it most.

We have booked our school psychologist Suzie Williams to provide another *Anxiety in Children* workshop for parents. She will talk about what anxiety is, how it can manifest, and some practical strategies on what parents can do to help support their child. There will also be time for a Q and A session, and we will have a display of our newly acquired anxiety resource books for parents to borrow from the library. The workshop will be after school on Wednesday 14th September from 2.45pm-3.45pm. If you are interested in attending please RSVP to the front office by Friday 9th September.

Finally, I'd like to recognise our students who attended the Interschool Cross Country event in Week 2. The whole group were enthusiastic and supportive of every runner who competed, and showed their appreciation by clapping loudly and leaving the bay to cheer on students as they ran past. In particular I'd like to mention Campbell Scott in Year 6, for 'Being the Change' on the day. Campbell recognised younger runners who tried hard but didn't win a place ribbon, by giving them words of encouragement at the finish line and offering his place ribbon, knowing he had plenty at home already! What a great Year 6 role model.
