At South Padbury Primary School selected students participate in the Instrumental Music Schools Services program known simply as IMSS.

Following a rigorous selection process at the end of Year 4, five students are chosen to learn the clarinet and five students are chosen to learn brass instruments, namely the trumpet or trombone in Year 5 and 6.

These dedicated instrumentalists receive a weekly half hour lesson from their instrumental teacher and then commit to daily practise of the instrument at home. Their family support them with encouragement and patience as they begin to learn and them eventually master the technical difficulties and skill required to play.
