Decision has been made to terminate the BYOD program, it will be phased out by years end, meaning students moving into year three next year will not need to supply an iPad for school, with the school looking to lease iPads/laptops/notebooks for years 3,4,5,6. Laptops/notebooks are what is expected to be used in high school so years 5 and 6 will focus on getting to know the ins and outs of those, as even though the systems may be slightly different the basic operation will be similar. We still need to have iPads or tech devices as Naplan is all run online, but we want to go back to the play based style of learning, as studies and data has shown a great benefit for health and wellbeing from the play based style of learning.  10.3. Recently we had results come in from the AEDC which collects data on the developmental health and wellbeing of all children starting school. we noticed a decline in the social competence and emotional maturity (being able to function well in a group) between the last study done and this one, which only confirms the above idea of moving back to play based style of learning as a far better idea, as it teaches kids how to share and experience the ups and downs like real life will, so we as a school think it's the right way to go.  10.4.
